## **Significant restructuring of ownership at Auratum Oy**

Ajanta Oy and Rausanne Oy have jointly decided to sell off their shareholdings in Auratum Oy. The decision follows Ajanta Oy's long-standing intention of withdrawing its ownership in the company.

"Ajanta is a major shareholder in Elisa, for example, while Auratum has divested its holdings in teleoperators. Both Ajanta and Auratum also operate on the real estate investment market as independent players. Ari Salmivuori and I will continue our cooperation in the asset management and capital investment companies," says Rauno Puolimatka.

The current Auratum Oy will be dissolved and Rausanne Oy has established a new company under the same name. The new Auratum Oy was entered in the trade register on 20 March 2007, at which time the name of the previous Auratum Oy was changed to Vanha Auratum Oy.

Auratum Real Estate Oy will become a wholly-owned subsidiary of the new Auratum Oy, while ownership of Aurator Asset Management Oy and Aura Capital Oy will be divided between Ajanta and the new Auratum Oy.

The current Auratum Oy will sell off its remaining shareholdings at an advantageous time. The aim is to complete the majority of divestments within the first half of 2007. These arrangements will have no impact on employees.
